



Yearly Goals for 2 & 3 Year Old's

Literacy:

- Able to sing The Alphabet Song
- Sings or recites simple words or songs
- Visual Knowledge of the Alphabet
- Beginning Knowledge of Letter Sounds
- Auditory Knowledge of their first Name
- Visual recognition of their first name
- Knowledge of age
- Able to make themselves understood verbally

Mathematics:

- Verbally recognizes numbers 1-10
- Ability to count to 30
- Ability to count concrete objects up to 5
- Understand the concept of same/different

Art/Shapes

- Ability to name basic colors
- Ability to name basic shapes
- Ability to create art when given materials
- Tries to stay inside the lines when coloring

Fine Motor Skills

- Ability to hold a pencil, crayon, and paintbrush
- Beginning knowledge of how to properly hold a pair of scissors
- Ability to build things with the help of others
- Ability to cut a piece of paper
- Ability to stack 2-5 small blocks
- Uses eating utensils properly
- Makes a line or circles with writing utensils
- Able to complete 10 piece puzzle or less by themselves

Language

- Points to and names one or two pictures
- Uses "Jargon" (talks to self, adults may not understand)
- Points to and names several body parts
- Enjoys listening to simple stories and books
- Uses the word "No" in correct context
- Speaks in three or four word sentences
- Verbally relates experiences to others
